TRANSPORTATION DIVERSIFICATION

While cars are super useful, we also love to walk, bike ride and use the train. From bicycle parking, to being located amidst a wide variety of public transportation, to being in walking distance between three of the most popular neighborhoods in Dallas. We have a zero-idling policy and special spots dedicated to low-emissions cars in our lot. All of our bicycle parking is indoors, by our front desk, for ultimate security and safety.

DART Routes: We have the route 12 bus-line that runs within half a block of us and we are .5 miles from the Deep Ellum Station (Orange Line) & the Cedars Station (Blue & Red Lines). Both Stations are drop points for all scooter companies. We have found the Deep Ellum Station is easier to walk from, as we are on the same road just due South (two blocks past the bridge).
